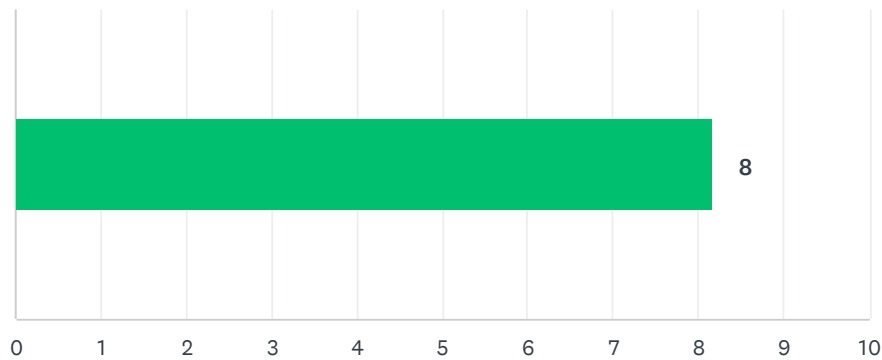

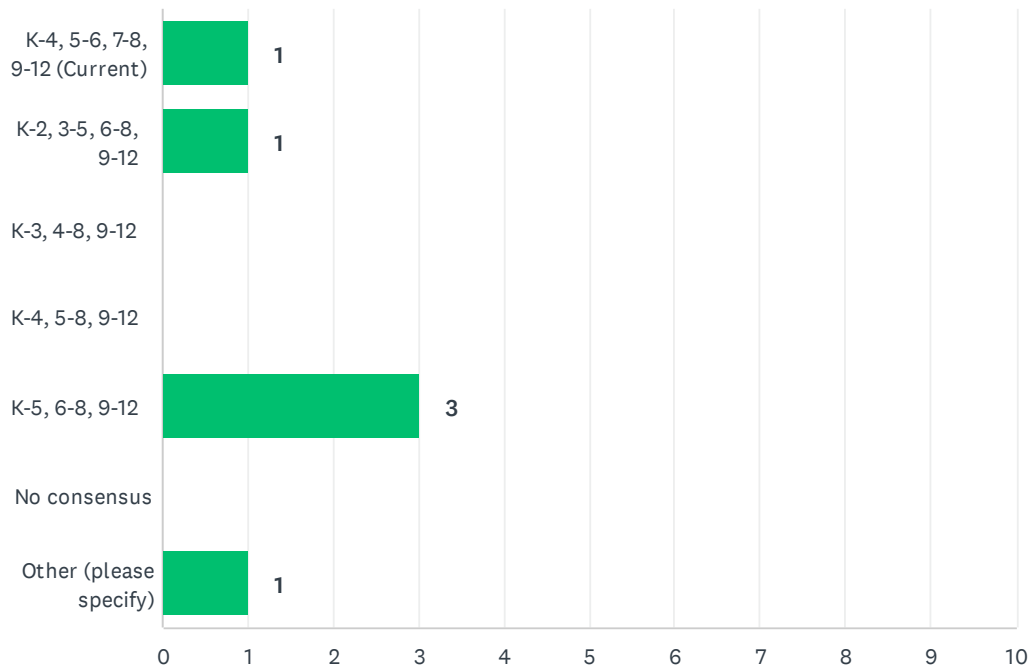

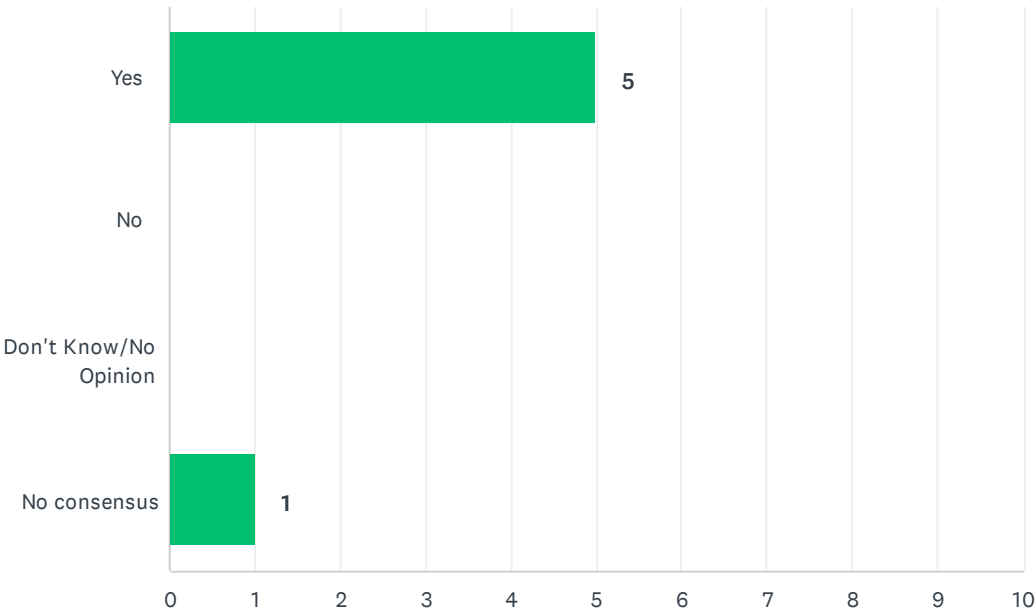

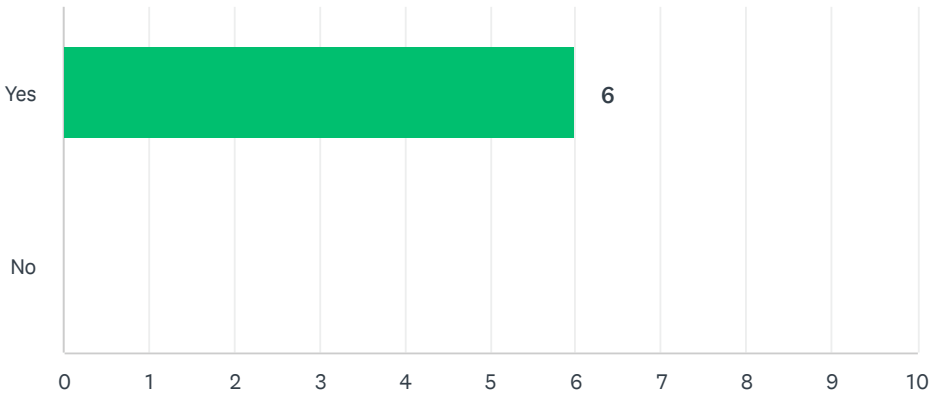

Q10 Did the School District's reputation impact your residential decision?

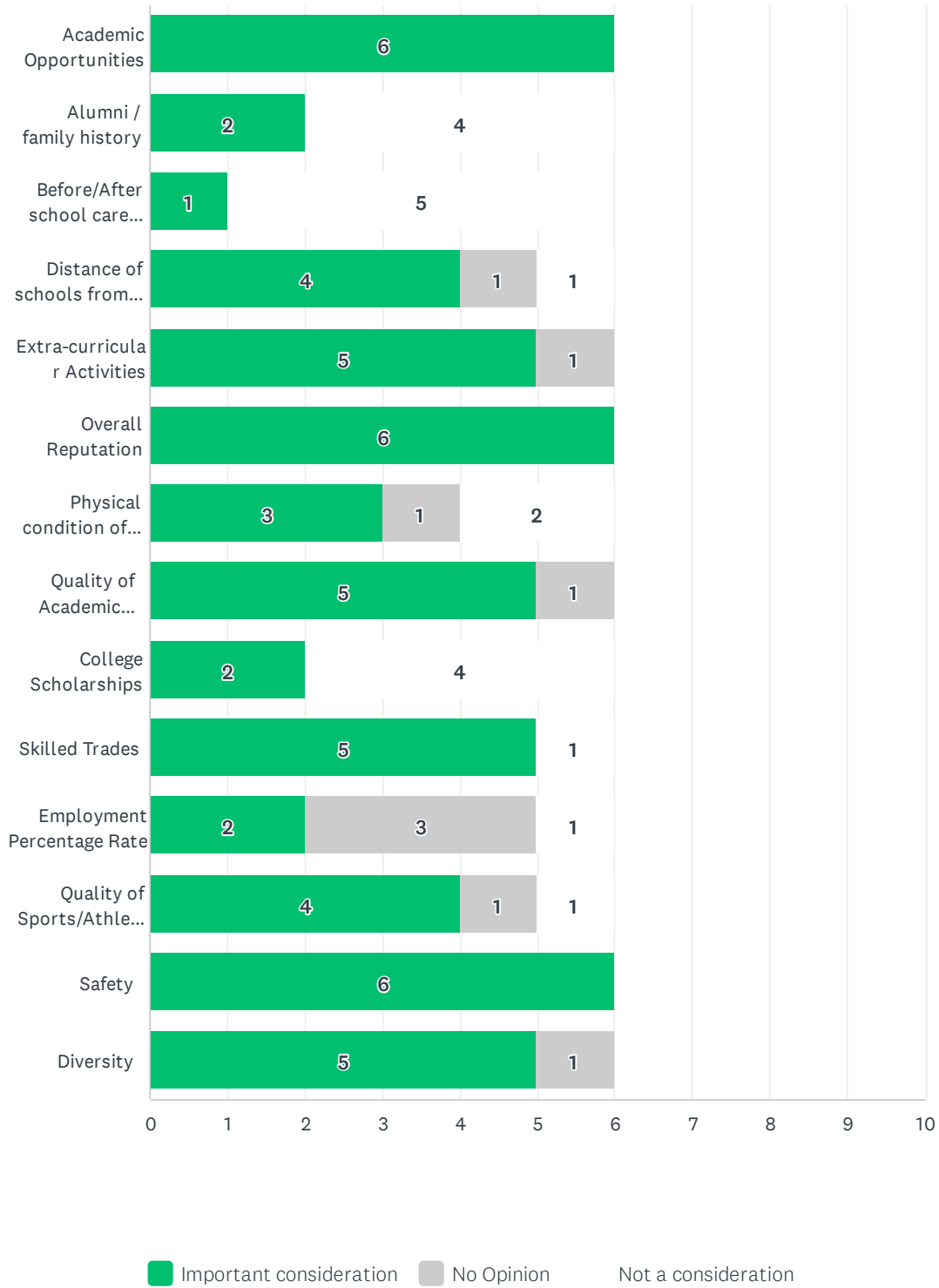

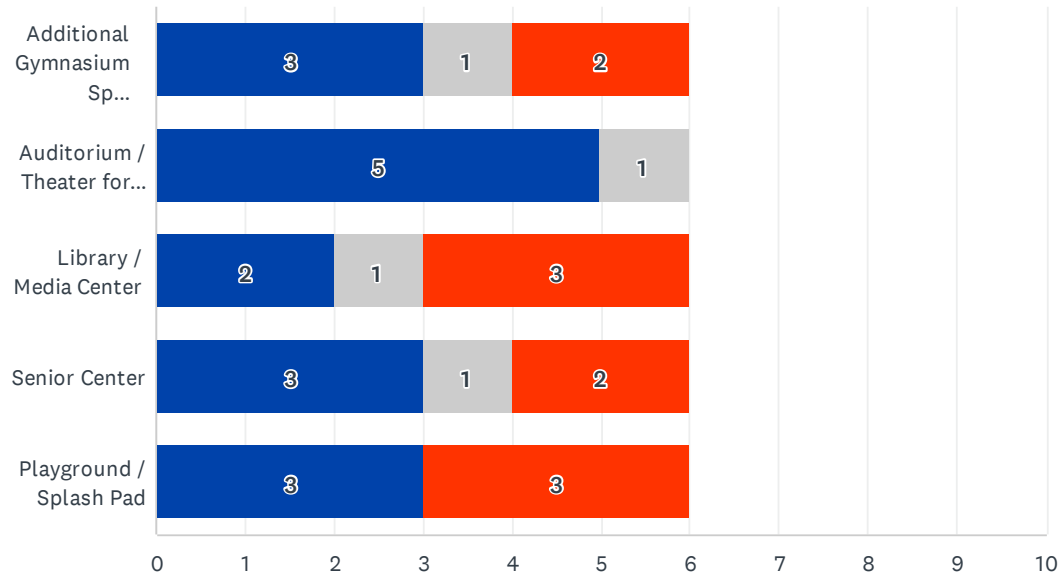

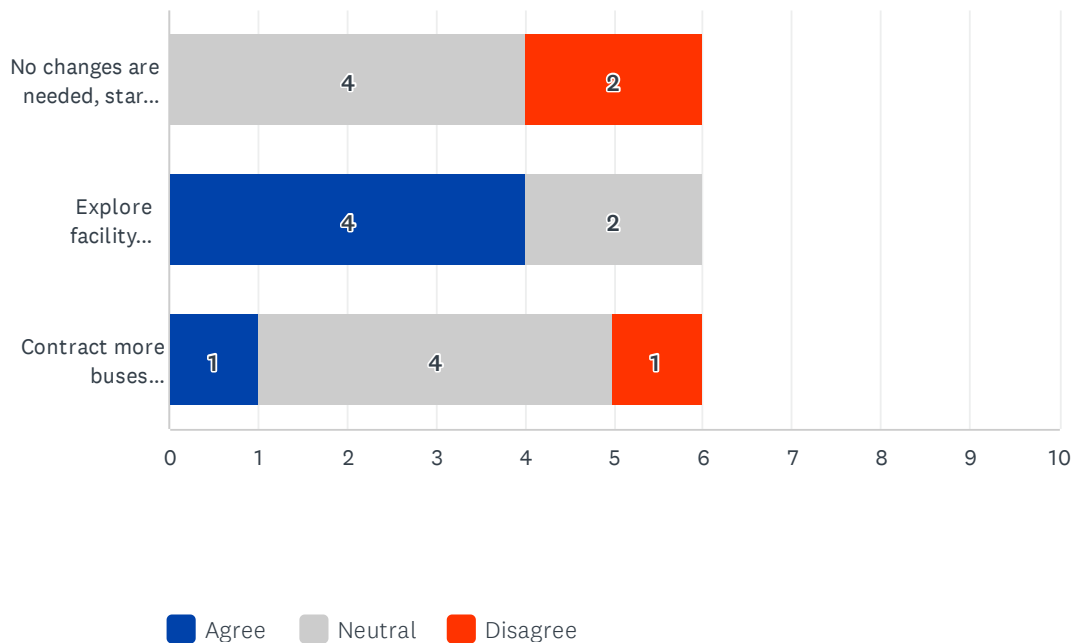
