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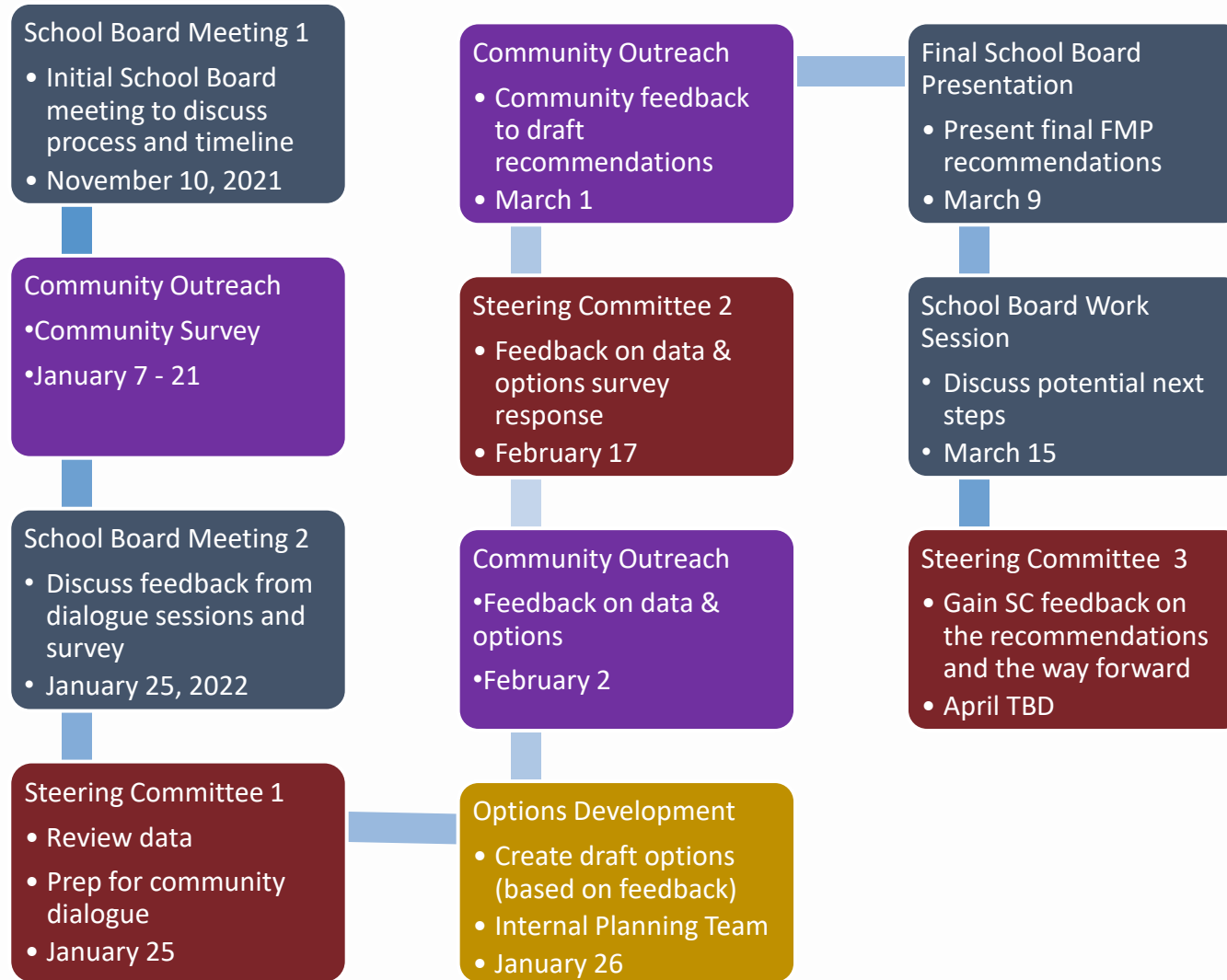
The mission of Idaho Falls School District 91, in cooperation with our community, is to graduate all students with the knowledge, skills and attributes they need to be successful beyond high school.

What should the plan contain?

- The goal of this process is to create the Long-Range Facilities Master Plan that will guide major capital investments for the next 5-10 years. This is our sole focus right now with the Steering Committee and Community Outreach survey data to-date.

How do we fund it & how long will it take?

- Once the Board of Trustees agrees on a Long-Range Facilities Master Plan, the Board will determine the best ways to fund it. Given the scale of identified need, bond funding will likely be part of the solution.

COMMUNITY SURVEY DATA

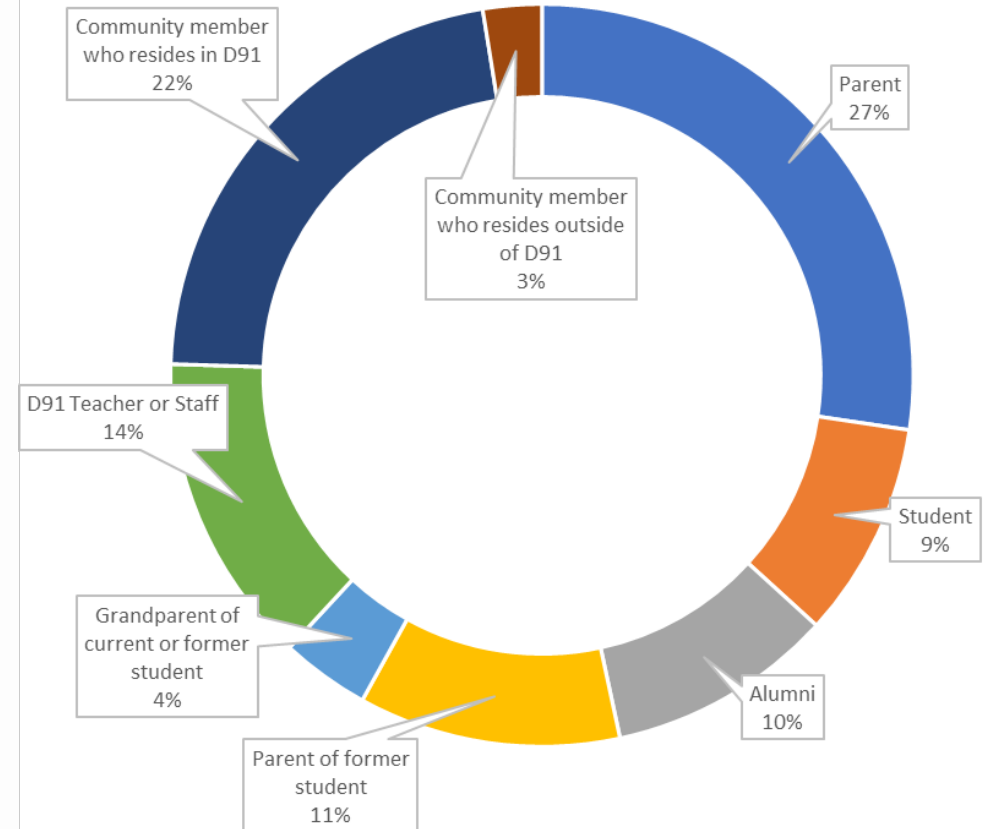


The community survey went from January 7th-21st. The survey was available in both English and Spanish. The intent of this survey was to collect input regarding future investments in our school facilities and to set priorities and develop a Facilities Master Plan for Idaho Falls School District 91.

3,089 total respondents

- **1,353** respondents were affiliated with a **middle school**
- **2,518** respondents were affiliated with an **elementary school**

Percent: Selected Affiliation



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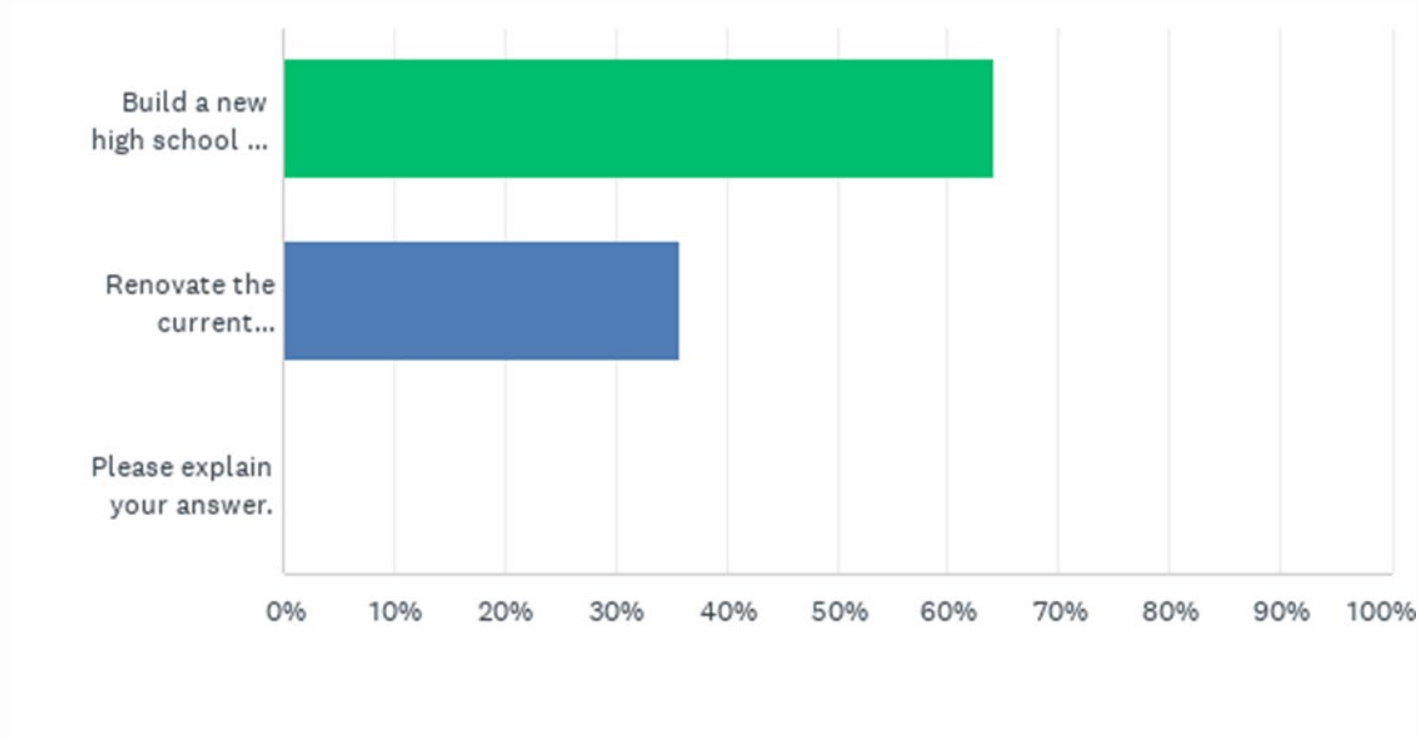

- 36% of respondents support renovating the current high school at the current location.



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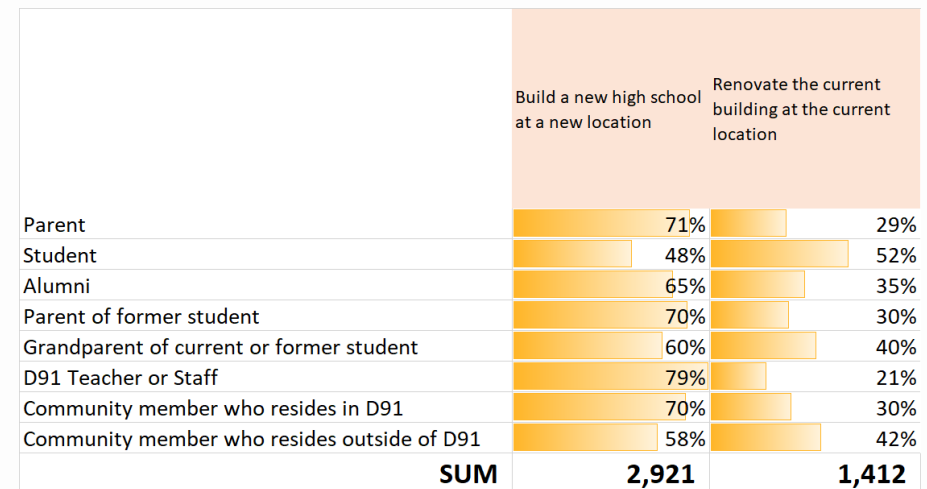
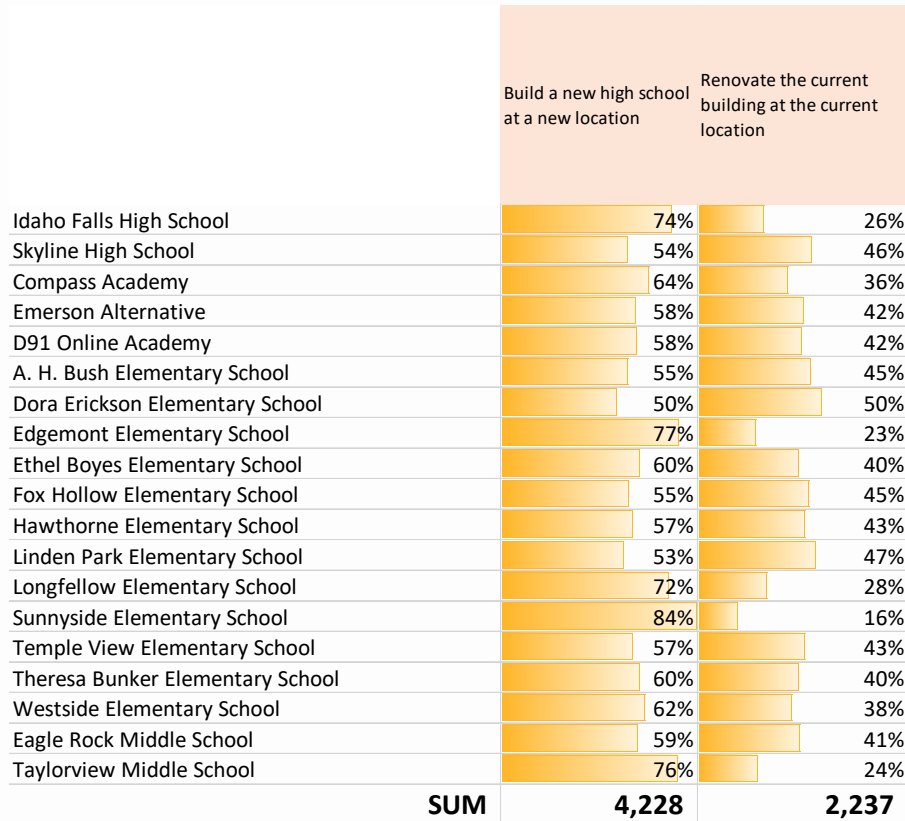

Decisions about building a new school or repurposing/renovation should be made considering what is most cost effective for the taxpayers and while meeting students educational needs.

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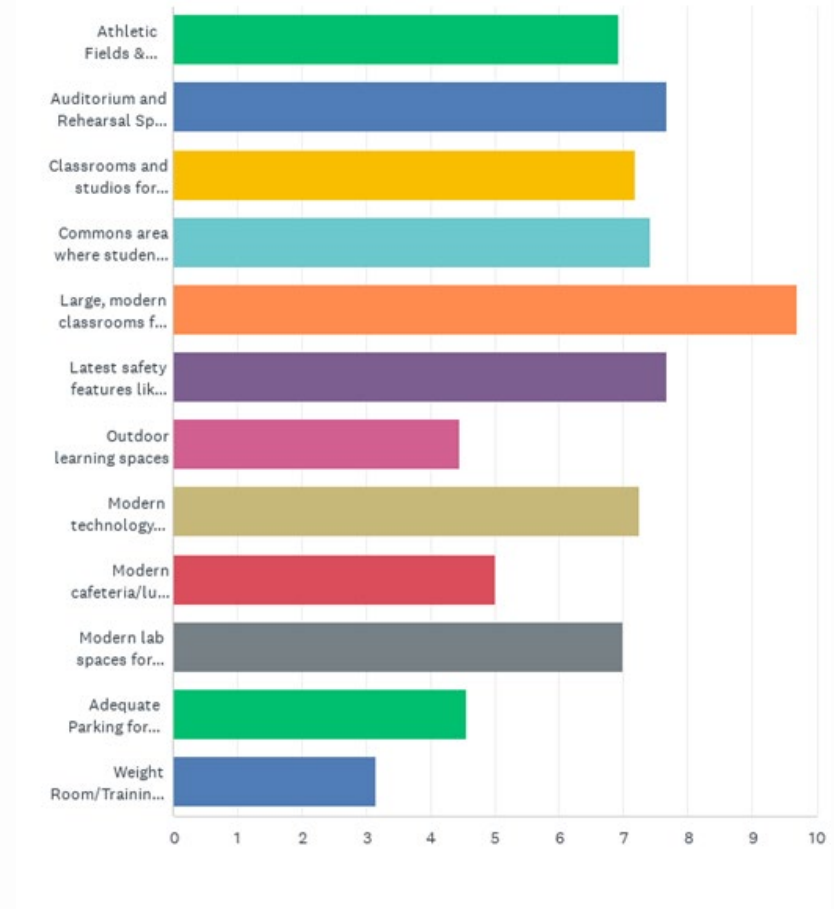

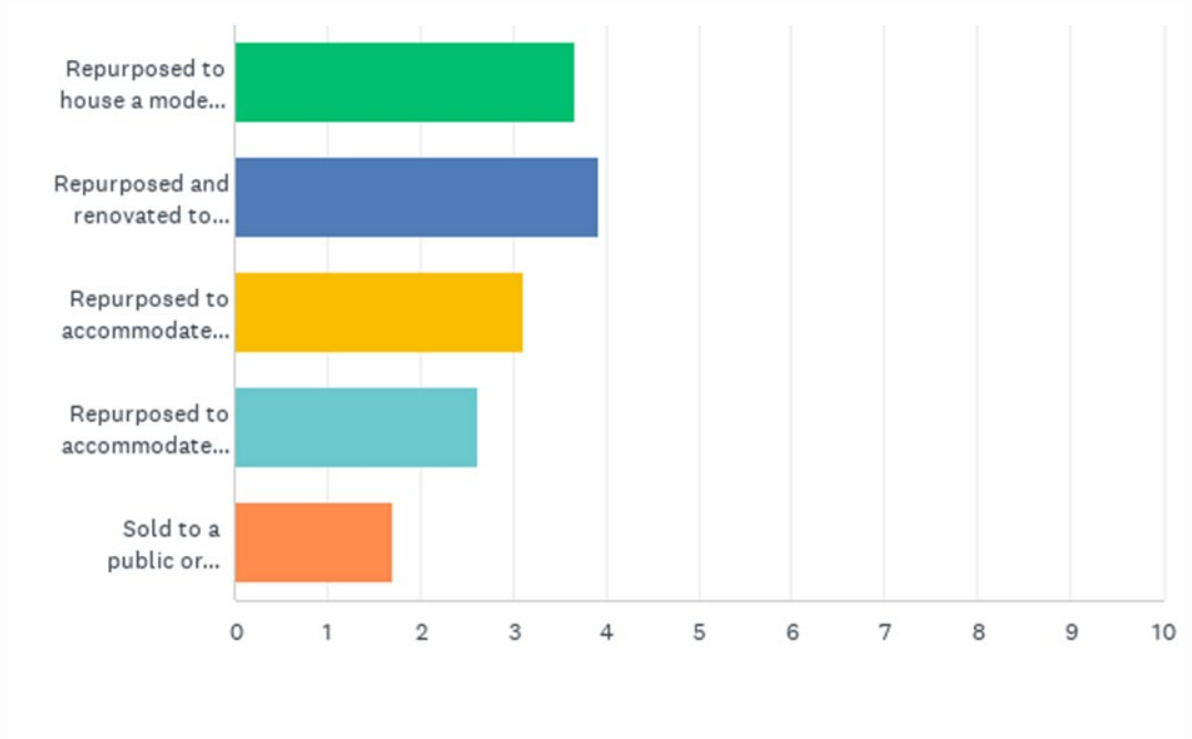


If Idaho Falls High School is rebuilt at a new location, please rank how you would like to see the current building(s) and campus utilized?

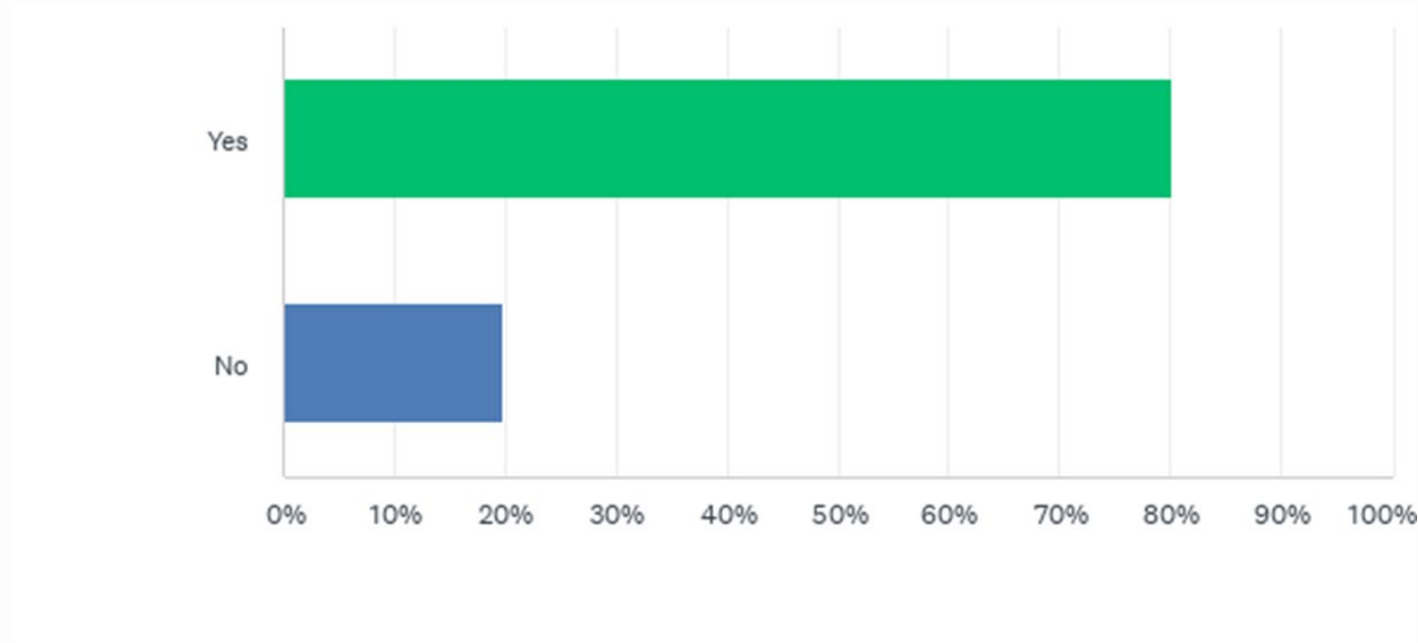

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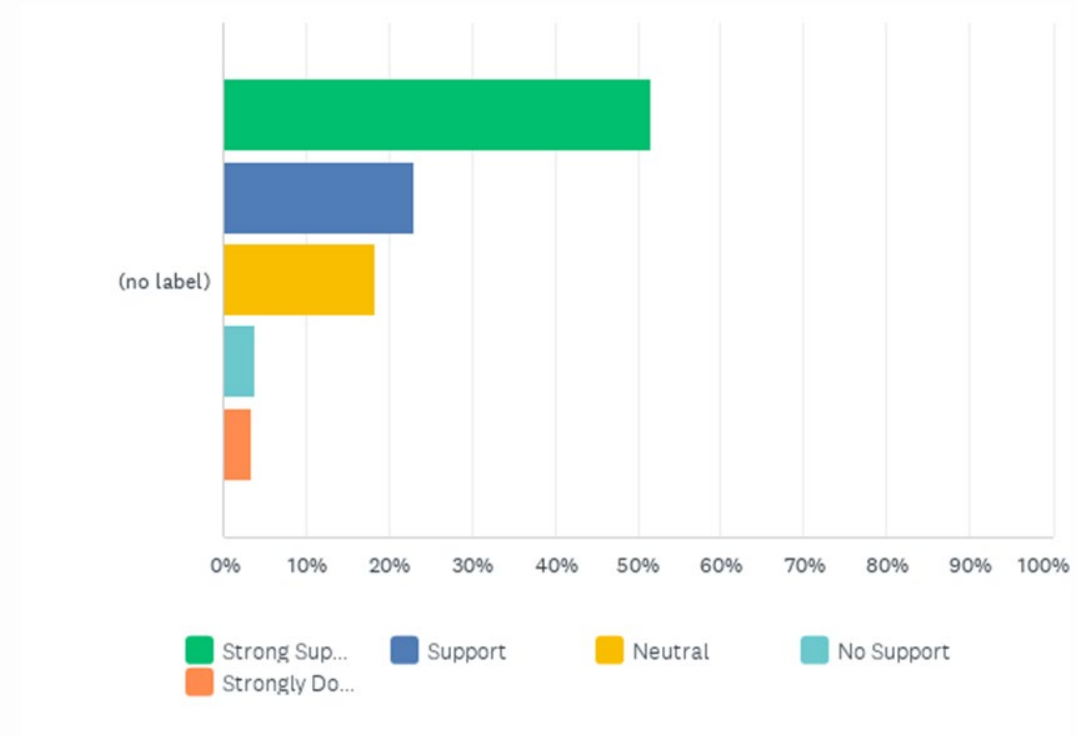

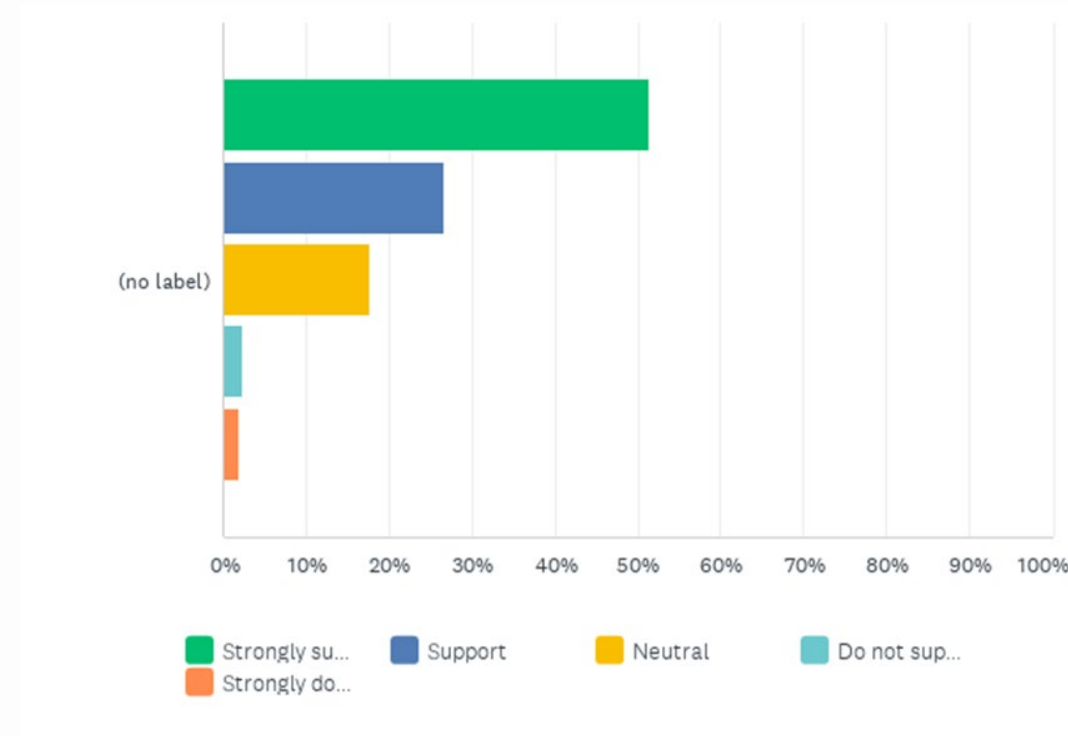

This proposal does not address the west side at all.

District would need to do a good job of communicating past the “sticker shock” and communicating real cost to homeowners and how it equals to cost per month. Some districts have shown it as giving up so many cups of Starbucks or Happy Meals per month, because our kids are worth it!

Also people might like that the IFHS building would be more preserved as a CTE than if a major remodel/rebuild was done!

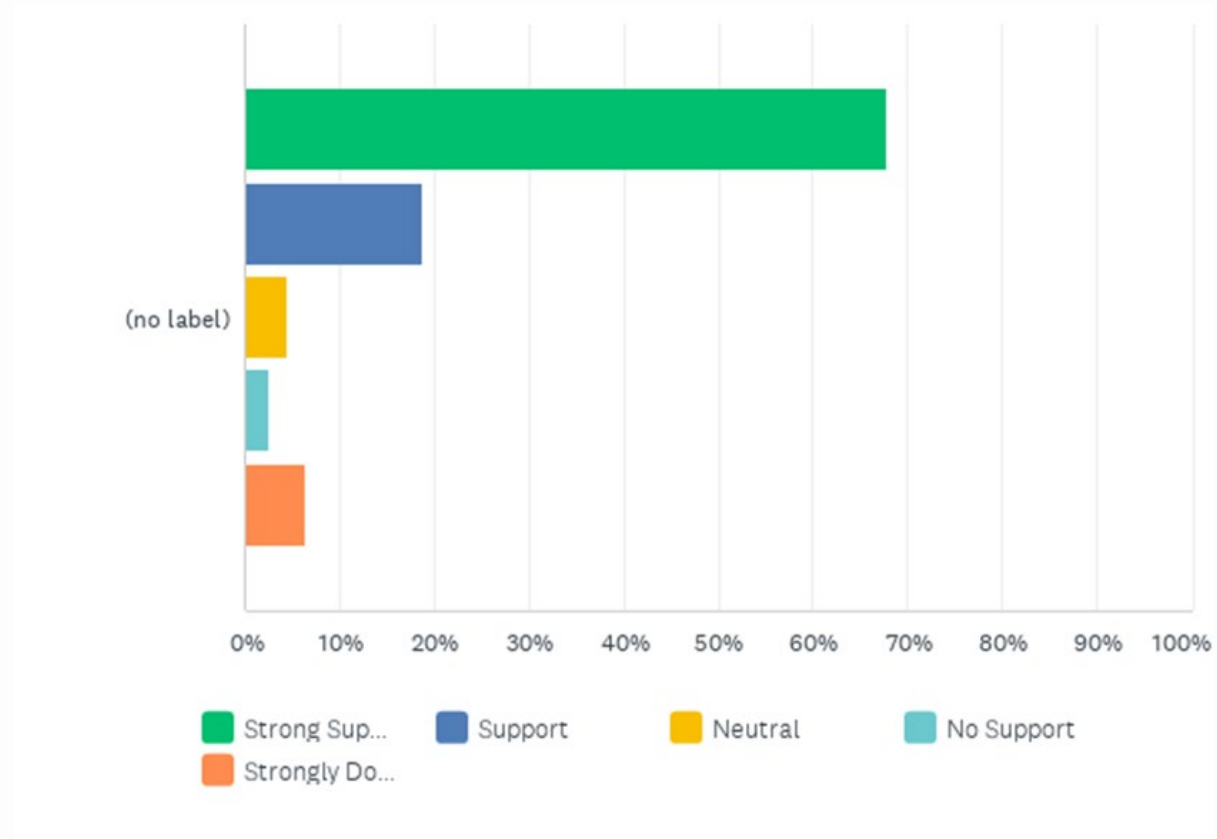

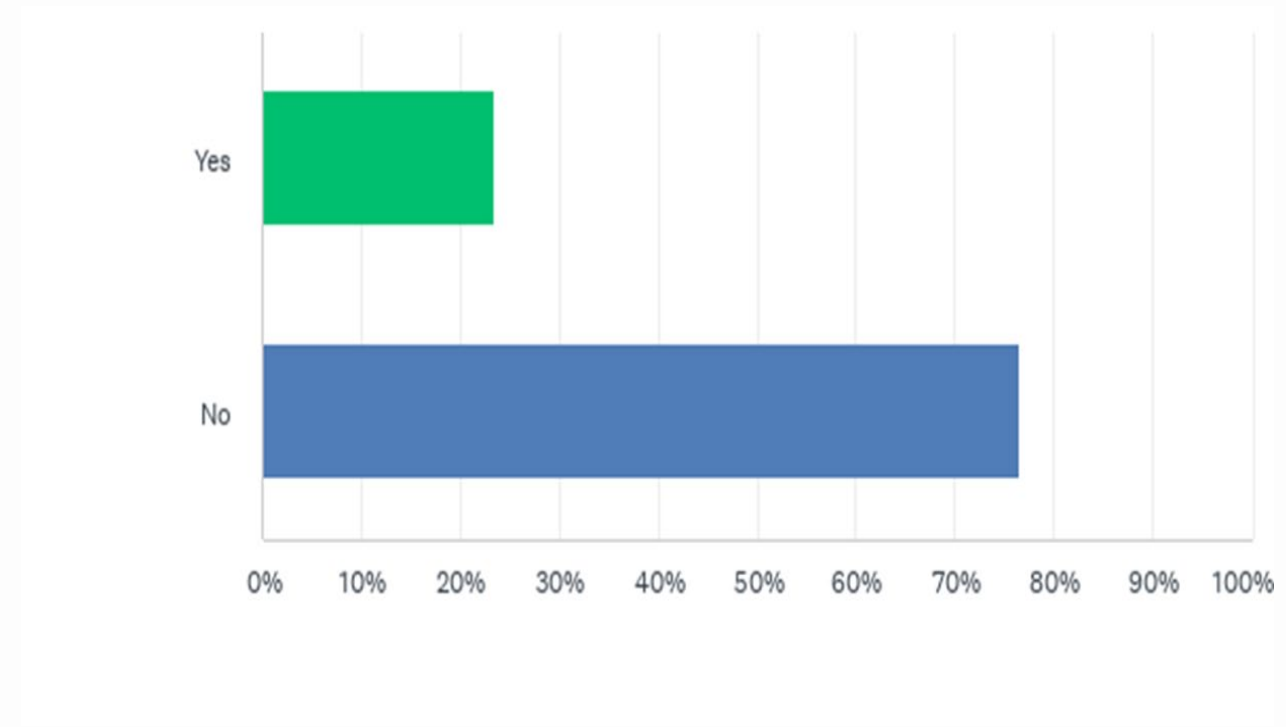




Are there any changes you would suggest to these DRAFT recommendations? If yes, please describe.

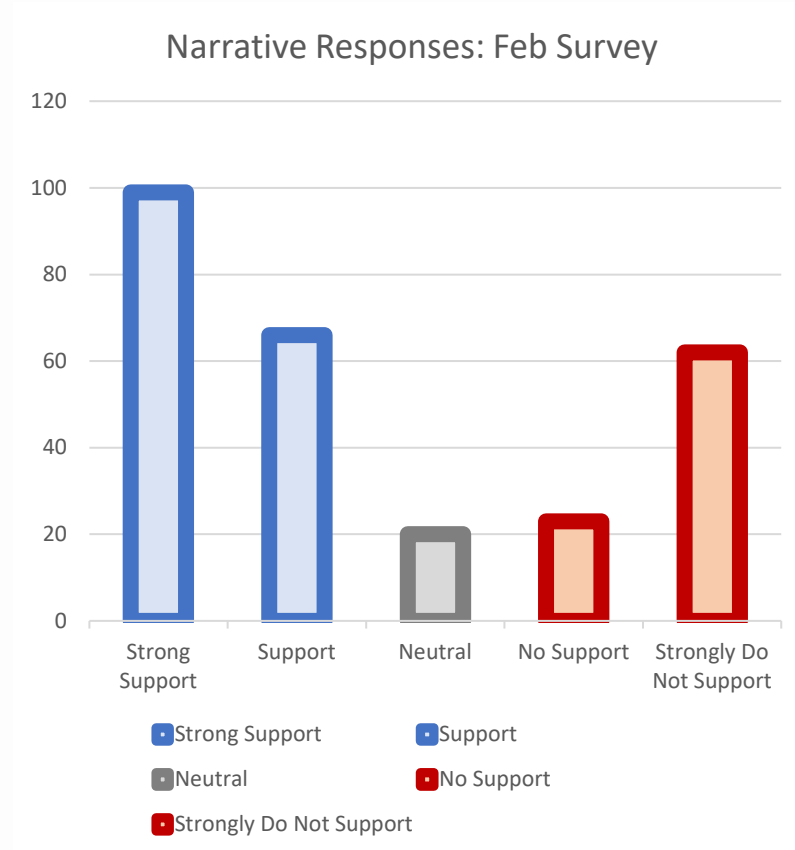

EXAMPLE NARRATIVE RESULTS

“ Please make the building of a new Idaho Falls High School your top priority. The current school is so overcrowded that the students walk to and from school in sub zero weather with no coats on because they can't get into their lockers and don't want to carry coats around all day. The overcrowded school is a health hazard in so many ways.

Parents in the district are supportive of rebuilding IFHS, however the voting population hasn't shown themselves to be.
